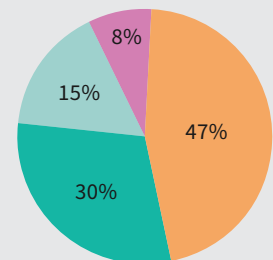
A NEW, NON-PROFIT COMMUNITY WELLNESS CENTER

In October 2014, Northern Nevada HOPES, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit health center, began construction on a brand new, 37,400 sq foot community wellness center in downtown Reno. The new three-story community wellness center, opening in December 2015, will allow HOPES to provide unprecedented healthcare to medically underserved populations in the Reno community, focusing on the uninsured, underinsured, and Medicaid recipients. In addition, as a federally qualified health center (FQHC), HOPES is able to offer 340b reduced pricing at its Pharmacy to assist patients who cannot afford to pay for medications.

The building will have three main clinics: Adult Primary Care, Pediatric Primary Care, and a Wellness Clinic. It will be a state-of-the-art medical facility, incorporating medical clinic pods that are designed to create more Points of Care, streamline patient volumes, and increase our medical providers' effectiveness and overall patient care.

HOPES is raising funds for its new community health center with a \$5 million capital campaign. HOPES is accepting monetary donations and in-kind gifts of medical and IT equipment and furniture. Monetary contributions support construction costs, furniture/fixtures, permits/fees, new computers, and medical/IT equipment. The aggregate cost to design and construct the new facility is projected at \$13.1 million.

To date, HOPES has raised \$2.77 million of the \$5 million goal. All funds raised will reduce HOPES' permanent loan obligation and future monthly payments. GIVING LEVELS

\$1,000,000 and above | Patient Lobby

There is one designation at this level with signage inside the main reception area.

\$500,000 | Wellness Clinic and Adult Clinic

There are two designations at this level.

There are three designations available for the Pharmacy, Laboratory, and Diagnostic Center.

Founded in 1997 to serve those living with HIV, HOPES expanded its services in 2012 to provide primary care services to adults. HOPES now operates as a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) and is a critical component of the healthcare safety net in the Reno community.
