New Additions to the Pharmacy:

Pharmacists are now providing MTMs (Medication Therapy Management) to Medicare-D HOPES patients which include, CMRs (Comprehensive Medication Review) and TIPs (Targeted Intervention Program). There are currently 101 patients enrolled in the Outcomes MTM platform and 134 claims have been submitted.

MTMs allow pharmacists to:

- Help patients overcome barriers to adherence
- Address gaps in therapy
- Educate on medications and disease states
- Reduce use of unnecessary or potentially harmful therapy
- Assess for adverse effects
